Policeman Shot in Leg in Huntington WV

Huntington WV: An off duty Huntington police officer was shot in the leg by an unknown assailant about 7:30 PM on 12/29 after stopping his private motorcycle to warm up his hands. The policeman has a single bullet wound to the calf as of the time of this posting. He was treated at Cabell Huntington Hospital and is recovering at home from his injury.
